CHANGE IS IN THE AIR

Ogle County Democrats and Bob Abboud Hit the Streets, Find Change Gets a Warm Welcome

ROCHELLE – Bob Abboud, 16th District Congressional candidate and nuclear engineer, joined Party Chair Muriel Messer, Ogle County Board member, Bobby Colbert and Democratic activists to canvass two precincts in Rochelle, IL Sunday, finding that what was once a Republican stronghold is now transforming into a community asking for fundamental change.

Sunday, May 18th was the first day of coordinated canvassing for the Ogle County Democratic Party. Ogle County Democratic Chairwoman, Muriel Messer expected a warm welcome, but didn't expect that welcome to come from Republicans as well as Independents and Democrats.
